Transportation Speech Topic

“If we live in a virtual world, do we need cars?”

Rules:

Speech Contest is open to any high school student who is at least 14 years of age, and not over 18 years of age as of September 15 of previous year (not having reached their 19th birthday)

Contestants must display a positive attitude and speech content must not be negative about the Institute of Transportation Engineers policies

Competitors must be at least 14 years of age and not over 18 years of age on or before September 1, 2021

Competitors must be a resident of the Greater Tampa area
(Including Florida counties: Hernando, Citrus, Pasco, Desoto, Manatee, Pinellas, Monroe, Lee, Hillsborough, Charlotte, Sarasota, Polk, Hardee, and Collier)

The competitor must prepare and present the speech personally. No pre-recorded video will be permitted

The competitor is not permitted to use any visual aids such as a PowerPoint presentation or poster

Speeches must be 5 minutes in length +/- 30 seconds. Short/long speeches will face point deductions

Judges may ask questions at the competition, but not to exceed 3 minutes per competitor
